Sample Itinerary*

B, L, D: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

DAY ONE (D) Upon arrival into Winnipeg by own arrangements, guests will transfer and check in on own to the Lakeview Signature by Wyndham Hotel, located at Winnipeg's International Airport.

The group will join their Frontiers North Interpretive Guide to tour the city of Winnipeg's popular areas, including the historic Exchange District and Forks National Historic Site.

Afterwards, guests will be invited to a welcome dinner where the guide will provide a brief orientation to review the trip itinerary details. Overnight in Winnipeg.

DAY TWO (B,L,D) Today we depart on a flight from Winnipeg to Churchill. Upon arrival, the group will set out for a Churchill and Area Tour visiting local and historical points of interest such as Miss Piggy, Manitoba Conservation's Polar Bear Holding Facility and the Inukshuk at Town Beach, weather permitting.

This afternoon guests will board a Transport Canada approved vessel to view the beluga whales that migrate into the mouth of the Churchill River. Then, across the river, the group will tour the Prince of Wales Fort National Historic Site, the oldest most northerly fort in the country. Overnight at a Churchill hotel. **DAY THREE (B,L,D)** Following an early morning breakfast, the group will step back in time at the Parks Canada Visitor Centre while viewing detailed wildlife dioramas and learning the remarkable history of the fur-trade.

Guests will then head to the Itsanitaq Museum which houses one of the most extensive Inuit Art collections in the world.

This afternoon, guests will board a Zodiac and embark on a guided excursion of the Churchill River and estuary. Experience the largest beluga whale population in the world at surface level, so close you could almost reach out and touch them. Dinner awaits this evening at a local restaurant back in town. Overnight at a Churchill hotel.

DAY FOUR (B,L,D) Today, guests will be transferred to the Tundra Buggy® Dock for a Tundra Buggy adventure exploring the Churchill Wildlife Management Area at a time when it is full of flowers, migrating birds and other wildlife such as caribou and arctic fox.

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

DAY FOUR, Cont'd Afterwards, guests will partake in an exhilarating dog carting excursion hosted by a local resident and dog sledding expert. Guests will have a chance to meet the team of friendly dogs, hear stories and enjoy a mile-long ride on a custom-made dog cart through the northern boreal forest. Overnight at a Churchill hotel.

DAY FIVE (B,L,D) Enjoy some free time exploring the community before today's flight back to Winnipeg.


